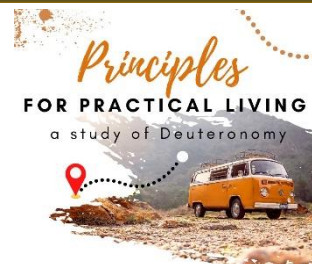


Revelation 4 – Heaven’s Throne Room

Join us in person or on zoom. We are studying the book of Revelation. See details below.

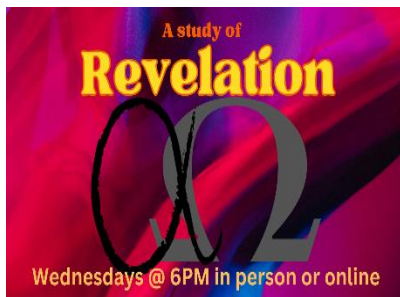
Sat, November 4th – Young adults (Sr. in HS – 20's)

2 Kings 18-20, 2 Chronicles 26-35

Hezekiah in context with the arc of kings:

- Judah varies & downfall of Israel (2 Chr 26-28, 2 Kings 16, 17)
- Decline after Hezekiah (2 Chr 33-35; 2 Kings 24, 25)

Hezekiah begins with _____ and _____ like a second Solomon:

- Restoration of temple, worship, and celebration (2 Chr 29-30)
- Destroyed false worship and rejected submission (2 Kings 18)

Hezekiah acts in _____ when faced with Assyrian threat:
