

Study in Daniel

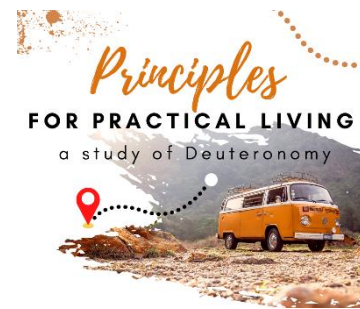
2 Kings 23:29-24:14, Daniel 1:1-4 – Setting for Daniel

As was his habit, King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon gathered fine youth to be trained in his court when he first conquered Jerusalem. This occurred before Judah's rebellions, which eventually led him to destroy the city and the temple.

Of these, Daniel became prominent in the court and renowned among the Jews. A contemporary prophet compared Daniel favorably with Noah and Job (Ezekiel 14:13-14). As God directed through another prophet, Daniel sought the peace of the city where the Lord placed him (Jeremiah 29:7).
